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Enigma 2.0 (September'16): The second edition of the event was held during UPES ACM's celebration of Engineers' Day and was based on decoding hidden messages using various encryption algorithms.

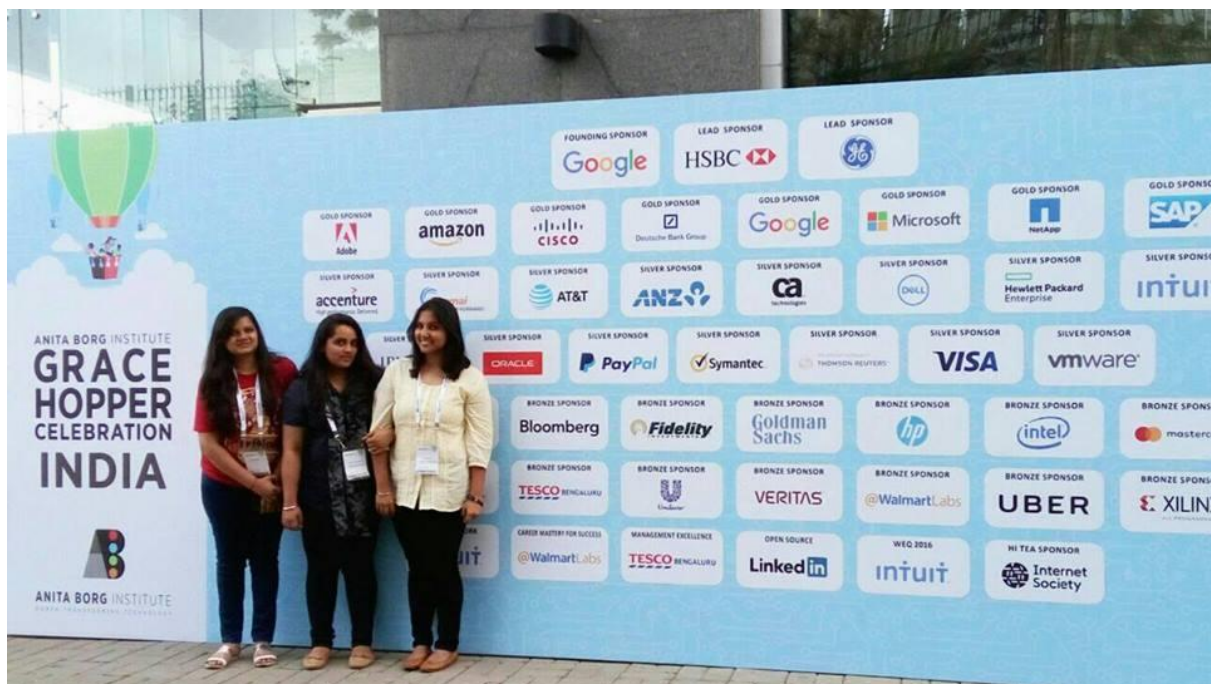


Crosscode (January'17): An amalgamation of crossword and code where the participants had to solve a crossword via outputs of blocks of code.

Ignite (February'17) - The chapter presented its share of innovation during University of Petroleum and Energy Studies' Annual Techno-Legal-Management Fest - Ignite, with 2 brilliant events—

- **Battle of Bots:** A battle which took place between two programs, and not their programmers.
- **Hackathon:** A massive 3-day long championship where teams had to create and present an application based on a given theme.

Teaching Sessions: Interactive sessions on web & app development, graphic designing, etc. were conducted by the student members for the freshers in the domain. A lecture series, 'SPY-C', based on C programming have also been conducted under the guidance of the faculty members.
