WOW! Successful SIGAPP Flagship Conference, SAC



SIGAPP fund balance has increased by an average of 12% each of the last 4 years, due in large part to the success of SAC

How do we do it?

- Call for hosting proposal. Hosts compete to hold SAC locally
- SIGAPP Chair and SAC Treasure do a site visit 6 to 8 months prior to the event
- Rely on local committee members to get best deals and prices, and student

How do we keep SAC registration fee low?

- It is kept under \$500 and includes coffee breaks, lunches, welcome reception, and banquet.
- Local host provides facilities, AV, local gift, and local entertainment.
- Local host solicits support from the local industry and government.
- Local host secures student volunteers for manpower to operate SAC.

What else do we do?

- Students have very low rate.
- Student authors are supported by SIGAPP travel grants.
- Attendees from underdeveloped countries are supported by SIGAPP travel grants.
- Keep acceptance rate round 25% quality papers and DL download revenues
- Run a Posters Program by invitation.
- Just started a Student Research Competition (SRC) program.
- Offer all attendees One-year free SIGAPP membership, paid by SAC funds.



Membership Retention Rate is Low



Membership retention rate is still low, 34.59%

What are current problems?

- Hard to improve the retention rates by paid membership
- Membership retention rate is not consistent for each year
- Most of retention is because of SAC's free membership

What would be Possible retention rate Improvement?

- Lower membership (student \$8 to \$5, regular member \$15 to \$10)
- Increase awareness of Applied Computing research
- Collaborate with other SIGs
- Increase member benefits Suggestions are welcomed
