

The 2008 Maurice Wilkes Award Call for Nomination

The Maurice Wilkes Award Nominating Committee is now open to receiving nominations for the 2008 Maurice Wilkes Award. The Maurice Wilkes Award is given for an outstanding contribution to computer architecture made by an individual whose computer-related professional career (graduate school or full-time employment, whichever began first) started no earlier than 1 January, 1988.

The recipient of the Maurice Wilkes Award will receive a prize of \$2,500 and will be invited to accept the award at ISCA 2008 in Beijing.

Nominations should consist of:

1. Name, address, and phone number of person making the nomination.
2. Name and address of candidate for whom the award is recommended.
3. A statement (between 200 and 500 words long) as to why the candidate deserves the award.
4. The name(s) and email address(es) or telephone number(s) of others who agree with the recommendation. Supporting letters from such persons are useful but not required.

Please send nominations (preferably electronically) no later than 4 April, 2008 to the Chair of the Nominating Committee.
