The current chapter website ([wics.cs.virginia.edu](http://wics.cs.virginia.edu)) was made from the Photon template by HTML5 UP. It was created using HTML5, CSS, JavaScript, JSON, and JQuery. The elected webmistress keeps the site up to date. The site is a single page with a menu bar attached to the top of the browser screen for ease of navigation.

The first section of our site shows our name and a brief description; we are known as Women in Computing Sciences (WiCS) at the University of Virginia. A button to "learn more" scrolls the page down to our "Purpose" section with a longer description of what we do and a photo from one of our social events this past spring. Next in "More about WiCS" we state that we are a chapter of ACM-W, explain the reasoning behind our name, and describe some perks to joining our organization.

The next section describes our High School Mentorship program with a link to the mentorship blog. The following section is still under construction but will showcase some experiences of members who have attended the Grace Hopper Conference. Next up is our event calendar, which is an embedded Google calendar maintained by the WiCS Vice President. We strive to provide information not only about our events, but the computing related events at UVA and beyond (e.g. hackathons and conferences).

This is followed by "Meet Our Officers" which lists the different WiCS positions and the position holder along with their picture and description.
