Our Recruitment Program

At NUST ACM Student chapter, we aim to provide students with opportunities to enhance their interpersonal skills, boost their confidence and widen their horizon about professionalism while exploring the new realms of technology.

The NUST ACM Student Chapter goes for multiple steps of recruitment in order to make efficient recruitment process in hiring the students and to ensure consistency in the performance of the teams. In the first phase, emails were sent to all the students through SEECS email platform where all student body is easily accessible about the recruitment drive for the Chairs and Team Leads. The applicants are mandatorily sophomore or Junior Year students. Competent candidates were shortlisted for the final interviews which were evaluated by President, Vice President and General Secretary. The interviews revolved around asking different strategies that they will adopt for uplifting the image of ACM chapter and making sure that every event goes smoothly. A potential candidate must be able to assess the performance of his team and makes sure that his team coordination is not jeopardized by unethical behavior of any team member.

In order to select the executive body, ACM conducted a seminar on the Orientation Day of freshmen where they were introduced to ACM culture and activities. We planned ACM – Day in the semester’s first week with the theme Pokémon-GO where different fun activities were conducted. Gift vouchers and food coupons were sponsored by different food ventures. These vouchers were given as token of appreciation to the winners of the games.

To approach a large audience at NUST, emails were floated to the whole school and hostel drives were conducted hostel drives as well to ensure that maximum people know ACM. Posters designed by the talented Media and IT team along with the Google forms were shared on Facebook groups of university and school to ensure that maximum students get to know about ACM Chapter and website as well (<http://acmnuust.com/>). The applicants interested in joining executive body were shortlisted on the basis of their applications strength. We at NUST ACM Student chapter have always tried to

accommodate maximum students to give them exposure about the practical life problems but due to restricted number of positions, competent applicants are selected after the interview phase which were evaluated by Chairs of different departments and team leads along with President, Vice President and General Secretary.

In the year 2016-17, on the total 85 new general members were registered. A total of 141 applications were received for Executive team portfolios out of which 34 were selected. The total council consists of 57 individuals including the Office Bearers.
